

Graf Zeppelin, New Battleship, Reaches Norway

Berne, March 6.—A Stockholm report received here this morning announces that the fourth German 35,000-ton battleship constructed under the 1936 German naval program, the Graf Zeppelin, has been commissioned and arrived at Nordfjord, Norway, where she is to be stationed for the present.

Three other important units of the German Navy, the Scharnhorst, Gneisenau and Prinz Eugen, are also reported in Norwegian waters at Trondheim undergoing repairs necessitated by the severe beating they received from the British after their escape from Brest.
